



SCHEDULE OF FEES

APPLICATION AND ENROLLMENT FEE

At the time of application, a non-refundable \$100 application fee is due for each new student and must be paid online in order to submit the application through the FACTS Management Portal. An Online Processing Fee of \$20 for each applicant will be charged by FACTS to cover application and enrollment form processing. Once a student has been accepted, the online enrollment form and contract must be submitted with the non-refundable \$350 enrollment fee.

RE-ENROLLMENT

Re-enrollment opens on January 6, 2023. In order to guarantee your student's seat for the 2023- 2024 school year, the online enrollment file should be submitted by January 20, 2023. The non-refundable re-enrollment fee for returning students shall be \$350 and must be paid in order to submit the enrollment documents. Students that re-enroll after April 1 will pay a \$375.00 re-enrollment fee. An Online Processing Fee of \$10 for each returning student will be charged by FACTS to cover enrollment processing. A student cannot begin classes or participate in upcoming school year related activities, athletic practices or camps until re-enrollment has been finalized. Re-enrollment is not automatic. Academic, behavioral, financial, and other reasons may result in the school rescinding the offer to re-enroll.

TUITION AND FEES

THE FEES LISTED BELOW INCLUDE: Tuition, Textbooks, Science Lab Fees, Student Catastrophic Insurance, and Yearbook. Additional fees will be charged when a student enrolls in elective course work (such as dual credit courses), extracurricular activities (such as private music lessons), or athletics.

Grade K2-K5 (half-day*):	\$7,600 annually for one child \$7,300 annually for 2 or more children	*Half day program is 8:00 AM – 12 Noon daily.
Grade K2-K5 (full-day*):	\$10,800 annually for one child \$10,400 annually for 2 or more children	*Full school day is 8:00 AM – 2:45 PM.
Grades 1-4:	\$11,800 annually for one child \$11,600 annually for 2 or more children	
Grades 5-8:	\$12,700 annually for one child \$12,500 annually for 2 or more children	
Grades 9-12:	\$13,300 annually for one child \$13,000 annually for 2 or more children	

TUITION AND FEE DISCOUNT FOR ACTIVE MEMBERS OF FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH

Active members of First Baptist Church receive a 10% discount on the regular one child and two or more children tuition rates.

NEW STUDENT FACILITY FEE

A one-time facility fee is required for all new students. This fee assists in addressing the cost of school facilities and maintenance. The fee of \$500 for each new student, not to exceed \$1000 per family in that year, is due by October 1st of the first academic year of attendance.

ACTIVITY FEE

The activity fee covers the following:

Grade K2-K5	\$225/year	Basic classroom and art supplies, and local field trips.
Grades 1-6:	\$225/year	Basic classroom supplies, local field trips, and club activities.
Grades 7-12:	\$225/year	Basic classroom supplies, Club dues, local field trips, dances (excluding prom), school and academic awards and academic competitions.

GRADUATION FEE

\$100 annual (This is for 12th graders only.)

\$ 30 annual (This is for 8th graders only.)

\$ 15 annual (This is for 5-year kindergarten students only.)

FEES FOR ELECTIVE COURSE WORK AND EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

A student electing to enroll in an elective course or extracurricular activity at First Baptist may be charged an additional fee as required.

DUAL CREDIT COURSES

A student may elect to enroll in a dual credit course offered at First Baptist School, through Trident Technical College. The student may receive high school and college credits for designated courses. The student is responsible for any costs associated with dual credit courses and will be billed by and paid directly to Trident Technical College. Information will be given to the student upon enrollment in a course.

JUNIOR – SENIOR PROM FEE (TO BE PAID BY ALL 11TH GRADE STUDENTS)

\$50.00 (one-time fee)

SPORTS FEES

ATHLETIC FEE: \$150 per student for each sport played on the Junior Varsity or Varsity level.

\$75 per student for each sport played on a team below the junior varsity level.

This fee is used to cover student athletic insurance and athletic facility expenses. Other fees may be charged for individual sports as directed by the athletic department.

FINE ART PROGRAMS

Fine art programs, such as individual music lessons, dance lessons, and drama programs are offered during and after school at an additional cost. These fees are set in the spring and will be sent out with the applications for these programs prior to the beginning of the next school year.

EXTENDED DAY PROGRAM

Offered weekly or by the day at an additional cost. The extended day program is available from the end of school until 5:30 PM five days a week. It is not available during school holidays.

PAYMENT PLANS

Annual, Bi-annual, Quarterly and Monthly tuition payment plans are available. Parents that choose to pay the full tuition in one annual payment by June 1 will be given a two percent discount for the tuition fee. All accounts must be paid in full by May 20th of the school year.
