

Dear First Baptist Families,

In May, our second graders were excited to drop off the pop tabs collected last school year at the Ronald McDonald house here in Charleston. We will continue to collect pop tabs as a community service project this year and ask that you please start saving your pop tabs! Ask neighbors, relatives, and friends to help us with this project. Tabs may be dropped off in the library where students in every grade can watch the collection grow!

Every tab donated helps the staff at the RMHC provide a temporary "home-away-from home" for families of critically ill children who are admitted to MUSC's Shawn Jenkins Children's Hospital.

HOW DO THE POP TABS HELP RMHC CHARLESTON?

The tab of soda, soup, and pet food cans is pure aluminum unlike the rest of the can, which contains paint and other residue. Once their pop tab dumpster is full, RMHC takes the pop tabs to a local aluminum recycler. Based on the price of aluminum at that time and the weight of the tabs, the recycling center gives RMHC a check. This money is used for their general operating expenses and truly helps to serve more than 900 South Carolina families annually.

We thank you in advance and look forward to helping make a BIG impact for the families at RMHC Charleston.

High School Counseling Updates

I can't believe we are beginning the 2023-2024 school year. I'm sure this summer flew by. Like many of you, I'm ready to get started with a new school year.

To those of you who are new to FBS school, welcome! We are excited to have you. I'd like to explain what my role is here at FB High School. As the college counselor, I see ALL students: 9th-12th. Typically in the fall semester, I toggle between seeing seniors and freshmen. I'm making sure my seniors are well prepared for college applications and that freshmen know who I am and we talk about the importance of a high school transcript and life beyond high school. Then, in the spring, it's about the juniors and sophomores. Preparation begins for juniors getting ready for life after high school and sophomore year, we talk about purpose/careers and use YouScience, our aptitude assessment. MANAGING BACK-TO-SCHOOL ANXIETY

As we have fully jumped back into school and attempting to settle into routines, I know with that comes school projects, homework, sports, and other extracurricular activities. Sometimes, these new routines can bring on unexpected anxiety and worry about getting things completed. As parents, we can assist our students by helping to establish healthy routines that can help with managing some of the anxiety and worry that may come with these new school responsibilities. Some ways that anxiety may present are changes in mood, being easily distracted, trouble sleeping and sometimes physical symptoms.

Some tips that can help to reduce some of that anxiety, could be taking deep breaths, stepping outside, physically moving around, allowing students a place to talk through the struggle by validating their feelings. Each child is unique in how they process and work, you know your child best and what benefits them. I also understand that there are different levels of anxiety and that sometimes we need more specialized attention.
